1. Planning applications:

19/02270/PLF – Mr. Paul Butler - Erection of a replacement dwelling at Moor Edge Hall, Moortown Road, Brandesburton – No objections to the application

2. Brandesburton playpark funding update:

Mrs. Hale provided an update on the grant funding application for new playpark equipment. Angela Peace from Mondegreen had been out to meet with Mrs. Hale to look at the playpark and Angela agrees that the playpark equipment needs to be replaced. At the present moment there is insufficient funding available from Mondegreen but this should change by the month end. Hopefully the parish council will hear very soon as to how much grant funding has been awarded to replace the equipment. Mrs. Hale had previously applied for £60,000 but this figure could change. Mrs. Hale is going to apply to the National Lottery on behalf of the parish council for funding to pay for a MUGA. This will cost in the region of £10,000. There is a 6-week lead time with the supplier but the parish council are hopeful that the work can be completed by the end of Autumn. A quote has been received from Humberside Security Services to supply CCTV equipment. 2 further quotes are to be obtained.
